Dr Seamas Donnelly (MB MD FRCPI) is Medical Director of the Clinical Research Centre (CRC) at St. Vincent's University Hospital & University College Dublin (UCD). He is a leader in Translational Medicine and as a Cell and Molecular Biologist his research group has defined key inflammatory regulatory events which drive chronic inflammatory diseases such as asthma, cystic fibrosis and rheumatoid arthritis. He is a Science Foundation Ireland (SFI) Principal Investigator Programme grant holder and has successfully obtained additional research funding from the Wellcome Trust and the European Union. More recently, as Medical Director of the CRC at St. Vincent's University Hospital he has been pivotal in initiating the establishment of integrated clinical networks in focused diseases which are used as clinical validation platforms for the assessment of novel remote technologies in disease.
